ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN

The Board of Selectmen of Goffstown New Hampshire, ordain as follows:

- I. TITLE: This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the PARKING PROHIBITED ON WEST SIDE OF PROSPECT STREET ordinance of the Town of Goffstown.
- II. AUTHORITY: 31:39 I (g), RSA 47:17, VII, VIII, and XVIII.
- III. DECLARATION OF PURPOSE: To prohibit the driver of any vehicle from parking such vehicle on the westerly side of Prospect Street, thus allowing for the free flow of traffic and the safety of pedestrians, drivers and access to the area by emergency service providers and DPW vehicles. The enactment of this ordinance will supersede and rescind all previous parking ordinances pertaining to Prospect Street.
- IV. ENFORCING AUTHORITY:
 - A. The Department of Public Works shall post authorized NO PARKING signs in appropriate locations along the West Side of Prospect Street
 - B. This ordinance shall be enforced by the Goffstown Police Department after the posting of appropriate authorized signs
- V. PENALTIES: Unless otherwise stated, any person or unnatural person within the meaning of the Criminal Code, who violates an ordinance shall be guilty of a violation. Pursuant to RSA 502-A:11-a, the District Court shall have jurisdiction of the prosecution of any violation of the Town of Goffstown Ordinances. All fines collected shall be for the use of the Town. The Town may enforce to the maximum penalty allowed by law. The enforcement authority may issue a summons and complaint along with a notice of fine pursuant to the procedures for pleas by mail set out in RSA 502-A:19-b.
- VI. WAIVERS: The Board of Selectmen retains the authority to waive any or all provisions of this ordinance for emergencies at a duly noted meeting.
- VII. EXCLUSIONS: These requirements shall not apply where such matters are governed by State Law.
