Project includes: Approximately 700 linear feet of drainage pipe work along Pineridge Street and Cross Street R.O.W with connection to existing drainage on South Mast Road and East Union Street. The work will also include installation of a catch basin in between an existing drainage pipes located at 90 South Mast Road. Verify with ENGINEER prior to beginning work. Major items of work include: clearing and grubbing, replacement and installation of drainage; reconstruction of bituminous sidewalk, reset granite curb and providing hot bituminous pavement applied in base and wear course.

- 1. Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

120 calendar days for substantial completion.

30 calendar days for contract completion.

Liquidated damages will be in the amount of \$ 750 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial completion, and \$ 750 for each calendar day of delay from the date established for contract completion.

- 2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price AND Bidder's "Buy American" Acknowledgement.
- 3. The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his bid.

4. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in whole or in part by {*check as appropriate*}:
 - a loan provided under P.L. 111-5, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA")
