

# Household Hazardous Waste

## What is it?

Leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients that require special care when disposed of.


## What to Bring

Unwanted household products in sealed containers

- Oil paints, stains, thinners, strippers
- Solvents & varnishes
- Adhesives, glues, resins
- Waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline, motor oil)
- Engine degreaser, brake fluid
- Transmission fluid
- Poisons, insecticides, pesticides
- Wood preservatives
- Photo chemicals, chemistry sets
- Cleaners, spot removers
- Swimming pool chemicals
- Aerosol cans
- Mercury products

## What Not to Bring

- Unknown compressed gas cylinders
- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
- Prescription medicines, syringes
- Infectious & biological waste
- Radioactive waste
- Asbestos (call for information)
- PCB's (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
- Fire Extinguishers
- Latex Paint



## Drop Off Items

- Propane cylinders
- Waste oil
- Antifreeze
- Wet & Dry cell batteries
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Lead sinkers

## To Ensure Safety, please

- Leave materials in original labeled containers and tighten caps/lids
- Pack containers upright in sturdy boxes and pad with newspaper
- Sort and pack items separately
- NEVER smoke while handling hazardous materials
- NEVER mix chemicals
- Do not place waste in a garbage bag
- Do not let children handle hazardous materials

The Goffstown Transfer Station accepts collections of household hazardous waste year round. The first 20 gallons or 100 pounds per year will not be charged. Any additional amount will be charged \$1 per lb.
