Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of:

2009 MAST ROAD SEWER PROJECT

Project includes: Approximately 5,000 linear feet of sewer replacement along Mast Rd. from Daniel Plummer Rd. to Rockland Ave. divided into three phases. Major items of work include: bypass pumping, traffic control, replacement and installation of sewer main and manholes, abandonment of existing sewer pipe and manholes, extension of all existing sewer services compaction testing, machine permanent trench patching applied in base and wear courses and manhole testing. Allowances have been provided to deal with potential petroleum contaminated soils.

Bids will be received by: Town Administrator or designee
at the office of: Board of Selectman, 16 Main Street, Goffstown, NH 03045
until **2:00 pm** , (Standard Time-Daylight Savings Time) on **November 23rd, 2009**
and then publicly opened and read aloud in the Mildred Stark Room.

1. Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

<u>One hundred thirty (130)</u>	calendar days for substantial completion of PHASE 1.
<u>Thirty (30)</u>	calendar days for contract completion of PHASE 1.
<u>One hundred thirty-five (135)</u>	calendar days for substantial completion of PHASE 2.
<u>Thirty (30)</u>	calendar days for contract completion of PHASE 2.
<u>One hundred (100)</u>	calendar days for substantial completion of PHASE 3.
<u>Thirty (30)</u>	calendar days for contract completion of PHASE 3.

Liquidated damages will be in the amount of \$ 750. for each calendar day of delay from the date established for substantial completion, and \$ 750. for each calendar day of delay from the date established for contract completion.

2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price.
3. The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his bid.

4. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in whole or in part by {*check as appropriate*}:
 - a loan provided under P.L. 111-5, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA")
 - a loan provided under the New Hampshire State Water Pollution Control Revolving Loan Fund ("CWSRF")
 - a loan provided under the New Hampshire State Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund ("DWSRF")

7. The successful bidder on this work is subject to U.S. Department of Labor's Davis Bacon wage rate provisions.
8. No Bidder may withdraw a Bid within 60 days after the actual date of opening thereof.
