


Town of Goffstown


Scope of work

Roy Park Pool



- Wet blast the old paint and loose plaster off the bottom of the pool
- Repair and fill any and all cracks found to prevent leaks
- Patch and repair plaster with a smooth surface for a final coat
- Caulk and seal all seems

Barnard Park Pool



- Wet blast the old paint and loose plaster off bottom of the pool
- Repair and fill any and all cracks found to prevent leaks
- Patch and repair plaster with a smooth surface for a final coat
- Caulk and seal all seems

Please provide the following information:

Describe repair methodology and include an itemization of materials and labor cost per pool, time line needed to perform work, proof of liability insurance, any warranty information, and three references who may be contacted regarding the qualifications and suitability of your company for this job. The successful vendor will submit a performance bond for 100% of the project cost in compliance with NH RSA 447:6. Expected date of completion will be June 1, 2011.
