

## **GOFFSTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT BID REQUEST**

### **CRIME SCENE PROCESS/MOBIL COMMAND POST**

#### **I. INTENT**

The Goffstown Police Department proposes to purchase and have constructed a mobile command post/crime scene investigation vehicle. The vehicle is to replace the existing mobile command post that is a 1989 GMC Special Purpose Vehicle. The mobile command post/crime scene investigation vehicle will be for incident command events, planned and unplanned, as well as provide the necessary functional equipment used to process crime scenes.

#### **II. EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS**

##### **A. Mobile crime scene processing/command post unit**

- Minimum 12,500 Lb. GVRW
- 5 Speed automatic transmission w/ overdrive

##### **B. BODY**

- 16' 1" X 96" X 84" h FRP body, 5/8" plywood core fiberglass exterior finish.
- Roof to be .040 smooth aluminum on crowned anti snag bows spaced 24" on center.
- Front corner posts and roof wrap to be 20 ga. bright stainless steel.
- Floor to be 2" X 6" tongue and groove southern yellow pine mounted to 80,000 psi 3" cross-members spaced 12" on center.
- Cab roof to be raised allowing for full height walk through.
- Side entry door.

##### **C. CONVERSION**

- Suspended ceiling with wall access for future wiring
- Roof top air conditioner
- Floor to ceiling storage capabilities
- At least two work stations with communication accessibility
- Minimum 5000 watt generator compartment mounted
- Minimum 100 amp circuit panel
- Removable external mounted 300 watt telescoping light towers
- Minimum 15 foot awning
- Minimum 27 foot pneumatic telescoping mast with compressor and pan/tilt/zoom camera
- Digital video recorder and minimum 20" color monitor

#### **III. RESPONSIBILITY OF BIDDER**

- A. Purchase chassis and body for conversion
- B. Provide two itemized quotes:
  - (1) Remove and re-install all current emergency lighting; and
  - (2) New LED emergency lighting installed
- C. Remove and reinstall existing radio system
- D. Start up and field test upon completion/delivery
- E. Minimum 1-year warranty on parts and service beyond manufacture warranty specifications.

**IV. BID SUBMISSION**

- A. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed envelope no later than 2:00 PM on May 20, 2013.
- B. Envelope will be marked for "Goffstown Police Department Crime Scene Process/Mobil Command Post" and addressed to: Town Administrator, 16 Main Street, Goffstown NH 03045
- C. Bids to be publicly opened 2:00 PM on May 20, 2013 in the office of the Town Administrator.
- D. The Goffstown Board of Selectman reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities in the bid process, and to negotiate any terms of the contract, which would not compromise the bid.
