2014 Pedestrian Bridges – Pleasant St & New Boston Rd

The Department of Public Works of the Town of Goffstown, New Hampshire wishes to solicit bid proposals for the **2014 Pedestrian Bridges – Pleasant St & New Boston Rd** located in the Town of Goffstown.

Information for bidders (Plans, Specifications, Forms, etc.) will be available at the Department of Public Works Office, 404 Elm Street, Goffstown, New Hampshire 03045.

Copies of plans and specifications may be obtained from Spiller's Reprographics, 880 Second Street, Manchester, NH 03102 (Mon-Fri 7:30 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.) The work involves the following:

The proposed work for the 2014 Pedestrian Bridges – Pleasant St & New Boston Rd will consist of removal and replacement of two existing pedestrian bridges on NH Route 13. Exact locations are Pleasant Street over Whittle Brook (near #17 Pleasant St) and New Boston Road over Bog Brook (near #105 New Boston Road). Major items of work include: water management plan/cofferdams, removal of existing bridge structures, installation of pre-stressed concrete bridge decks, gabion basket retaining wall, fencing, sidewalks and SWPPPs. Erosion/sedimentation control, dust control, and traffic control shall also be maintained throughout the project duration by the CONTRACTOR.

Bid proposals will be accepted on enclosed bid forms and must state the price clearly. All proposals must be in a sealed envelope and marked clearly "**2014 Pedestrian Bridges – Pleasant St & New Boston Rd**" and received no later than **10:00 a.m. on November 13, 2014**. Bids will be publicly opened and will be read at that time by the Goffstown Public Works Director or designee and the Town Administrator or designee at the Town Hall. Notification will take place after bids have been reviewed by the Department of Public Works and a recommendation is made to, and then awarded by, the Board of Selectmen.

A bid security in the amount of 10% of the bid and made payable to the owner shall be submitted in the form of a certified check drawing upon a bank within the State of New Hampshire or a bid bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in New Hampshire.

The successful bidder shall furnish a 100% **PERFORMANCE BOND AND PAYMENT BOND** and shall be required to execute the contract agreement within ten (10) days following notification of the acceptance of his bid. The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept any bid, to waive any informality on bids received, or to omit and/or alter any bid item.
