


REPEAL OF TATTOO HEALTH ORDINANCE (300.8)

The Goffstown Board of Selectmen voted on May 19, 2003 to repeal the Tattoo Health Ordinance (300.8). This ordinance was based on the former NH RSA 571:24 and adopted on May 6, 1986 and amended on July 2, 1990. The decision to repeal the ordinance was based on the following information:

- the legislative body passed a zoning ordinance at the March 2003 Annual Meeting to regulate the location of Tattoo and Body Piercing Parlors in the Town of Goffstown;
- NH state law under Chapter 314-A regulates the health issues related to tattooing and body piercing through the NH Department of Health and Human Services, which also enforces those health regulations; and
- a duly noticed Public Hearing on the repeal of the Tattoo Health Ordinance was conducted on May 12, 2003 and received no public comments.
