

Per RSA 231:191, the Town of Goffstown must employ load/weight restrictions during the spring thaw period. ***The Town's*** load limit policy (see below) is now posted on all roads, effective February 27, 2013. **This is done to prevent roadway damage and to protect the large infrastructure investment the Town has made.**

The Department of Public Works requests that residents make every effort to coordinate deliveries such as fuel and building supplies before the posting, or wait until the road postings are lifted, in approximately 4-6 weeks from the initial posting date. Waivers will be issued by DPW on an **emergency** basis only as conditions allow.
